NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- 1. Upon arrival to the trial please report to the steward board area to pick up your armbands and sign in for your class.
- 2. Exhibitors must be present prior to start of their class. Dogs must be at ringside when scheduled to be judged or risk disqualification. JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. Owners/Handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- 3. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.
