## Entry Information

**EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: EACH DAY THERE IS TWO SEPARATE TRIALS. EACH TRIAL IS CONSIDERED A NEW EVENT. THEREFORE, THE ENTRY FEES START OVER WITH FIRST ENTRY FEE.**

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Entries will not be accepted without proper entry fee. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via the email you provided. Make sure your **email address is CLEARLY PRINTED** on the entry form. **SHOULD ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

FIRST ENTRY: of a dog in each trial..... \$30.00 each  
Additional entry of the same dog, same trial.....\$20.00 each

If you enter online and the trial is already full you will receive a refund. Until you receive an emailed confirmation from the trial secretary your entries are not valid. PLEASE READ your confirmations for any notes from the trial secretary and to check over for typos.

Saturday's classes will be in Ascending order 4" – 16"

Sunday's classes will be in Descending order 16" – 4"

### **JUMP HEIGHTS**

If jump height is required you MUST supply this information on your entry form, without it your entry will not be accepted. The trial secretary is not responsible for obtaining this information

<u>Height of Dog at Withers</u>	<u>Jump Height</u>
Less than 10 inches	4 inches
10 inches to less than 15 inches	8 inches
15 inches to less than 20 inches	12 inches
20 inches and over	16 inches

Rally transfers from Rally Intermediate to Rally Advance require a jump height on the transfer form. You are expected to understand the Rally Rules and understand which Rally class "A" or "B" at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class, Intermediate and Advanced/Excellent and Master classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class! Consult the AKC rules for Rally at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org)

This statement is required by AKC that at every licensed or member club trial, included in the entry fee is a recording fee of \$3.50 required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog. (This is not a separate fee it is already added into the first entry fee) \*These fees are collected by the club giving the trial and paid to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC rule effective 9/1/2011)

On rally transfer forms if a class requires a jump height you as the owner/handler are solely responsible for that information on the transfer form. It is expected for you to understand the Rally Rules and understand which Rally class "A" or "B" at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Rally Novice, Intermediate, Advanced/Excellent and Master classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class! Consult the AKC rule book for Rally at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org). The trial secretary will not be responsible for supplying you that information.

**NO REFUNDS** after closing date except for Bitches in season. Please see policy below.

**Transfers:** After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to the next class level. This transfer may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title. transfers may be approved, provided the next level class and the judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Please contact the trial secretary for trial transfer forms. **Transfers will be allowed only up to 1/2hr before start of next trial.**

### **REFUND POLICY for Bitches in Season**

The entry fee less a \$8.00 processing fee per trial will be refunded upon written request to the trial secretary for a bitch coming into season after the closing date of entries for this rally trial. Due to workload, refunds cannot be made on day of trial; they will be mailed after the trial is over.

- **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SIGNED!** Mail entry with proper fees as per instructions on entry forms. Telephone, or e-mail entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms (including back side) will not be accepted.
- Judging schedule will be emailed 1 week prior to trial. (Please make sure you **PRINT** your email address)
- In the event of an emergency, MADTA reserves the right to Add/Substitute judges.
- Notice that MADTA may cancel any/all of this event due to extreme weather conditions or any other unforeseeable disaster/Virus.
- Judges are limited to 8 hours of Judging and that entries will close on the earlier of the specified closing date or when the limit is reached

## **RIBBONS AND PRIZE AWARDS**

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs with qualifying scores for each Rally class.

Prizes will be awarded in each ring upon completion of classes. Any Special Prizes will be awarded at the end of the Trial, at the trophy table, as the exhibitors present their related armbands. Prizes will NOT be mailed. Prizes not claimed will become the property of MADTA and may be awarded at a future Trial.

An acknowledgement rosette will be awarded to each exhibitor completing their title at our Trial.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Upon arrival to the trial please report to the steward board area to pick up your armbands and sign in for your class.
2. Exhibitors must be present prior to start of their class. Dogs must be at ringside when scheduled to be judged or risk disqualification. **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** Owners/Handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
3. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.
4. Dogs must use the identified exercise area outside the trial facility. **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.** Should your dog have an accident inside the facility please ask for cleaning supplies.
5. **No RV** overnight parking available at trial site. Hotels and Motels in the area are in the premium. It is recommended that you make reservations early.
6. Exhibitors are reminded to bring their own chairs, crates, water, matting for under chair & crate. etc.
7. A half hour lunch break may be taken by the Judges at their discretion.
8. **NO Food in the Ring at any time.**
9. **ALL DOGS must be crated except when being judged. NO FLEXI LEADS permitted.**
10. **Dogs NOT entered are only permitted with prior approval from the trial secretary.**
11. **DUE TO LIMITED SPACE. NO EX-PENS** allowed. PLEASE put your chair in front of your dog's crate. Please be courteous to your fellow exhibitor and offer to move over a little to make room if necessary.
12. The safety of the handlers and dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitor acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations for this sport.
13. Shoes worn by the handler must be closed toed. Handlers may not compete in bare feet. **NO flip-flops or open toed shoes permitted.**
14. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
15. All "warm ups" **MUST** be done **ON LEAD**. That means the lead is attached to the dog's collar and the handler is holding the lead. No Flexi Leads
16. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners™ Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
