A new contract has been accepted by the Golden Retriever Club to rent the building for a clinic which includes a clause that states that no bitches in season will be allowed in the building.

Becky Stewart explained the content of a letter from the AKC in regards to suggestions for improvement from the February Agility Trial. The suggested equipment has been bought (a new A Frame and measuring wheel). A training session is planned to help course setters be more efficient.

Dianne Bryant updated how volunteer hours are calculated and how Canine Cash is dispensed.

Dianne also announced that the defibrillator for the building has arrived and there will be an instructional demonstration planned.

Betsy Powers reported that the Rally Trial was a success and the competitors enjoyed it.

A suggestion was made to buy a new PA system to replace the current one.

Braggs were entertained and applauded.
